

Need to stretch your legs after a long drive to the MLTC meeting (or after the long meeting)?

Want to see some local land conservation in the beautiful Connecticut River Valley?

Come join us before -- or after -- Friday's MLTC meeting. We're leading 20-25 minute quick walks in Pascommuck Conservation Trust's 'Old Trolley Line Conservation Area'.

This easy but varied walk winds around valley bottom meadows with fossil oxbows and ends with a beautiful view of farmland protected by Pascommuck, Winding River Land Conservancy, and the APR program -- with the Mount Tom range as a backdrop.

We'll meet at 9:15 (and again after the meeting) on Clapp Street.

Follow the MLTC/Arcadia directions, but at the end of Fort Hill Road take a left on Clapp Street instead of continuing on to the Audubon visitors' center.

The entrance is $\sim 1/2$ mile from the intersection, just past a second open field. The entrance is on the left where there's a bike rack and barrier with signs. Park along the road.
