Regarding: Conservationist Pesticide Advisory Council representing Conservationists

Date: August 4, 2025

The Massachusetts Department of Agricultural Resources, Pesticide Program (“Department”) would like to announce that it is accepting applications for an individual to fill a vacant seat on the Conservationist Pesticide Advisory Council which currently represents Massachusetts conservationists.

Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 132B, the Massachusetts Pesticide Control Act (“Act”), allows the Massachusetts Department of Agricultural Resources (“Department”) to establish advisory councils (“Advisory Councils”) which provide the Department and the Pesticide Board advice as it pertains to the development of Department policies and regulations as they relate to the administration of the Act and the regulations promulgated thereunder (“333 CMR”). [333 CMR 4.00 et. seq.](#), establishes the criteria by which an Advisory Council is created and how it functions.

General Overview of The Advisory Council

- Members are appointed by the Pesticide Board through an application process;
- The Advisory Council is made up of five (5) members;
- The term of an Advisory Council member is three (3) years;
- Members are not compensated and serve in an advisory capacity only;
- Meetings are held once a month;
- Advisory Councils and all members must comply with the requirements of Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 30A, Sections 18-25, the Massachusetts Open Meeting Law.
